

Porcelain is extremely stain resistant, but as a rule, all spills should be removed as quickly as possible, including staining agents, acids, alkalis & colorants.

Always rinse thoroughly with water & dry immediately after cleaning

DAILY CLEANING:

Use a slightly damp microfiber cloth.

REGULAR CLEANING:

Use a neutral liquid detergent with a microfiber cloth or soft sponge.

STUBBORN SPOTS:

Use a slightly abrasive sponge and one of the recommended stain removers when necessary:

- Mild Dish Soap
- Mr. Clean
- Neutral Floor Cleaner
- 409
- Spic and Span
- Fantastic
- Windex
- Lysol
- Soft Scrub
- Mr. Clean Magic Eraser
- Bar Keepers Friend

Always test on a small, inconspicuous area first. Rinse thoroughly with water & dry immediately after cleaning.

DO NOT USE:

Do not use steel wool, this will leave metal marks on the surface.

While you should avoid cutting on the surface all together, do not use ceramic knives on your porcelain countertops.
