

Porcelain is extremely heat and stain resistant. Keep yours looking new by following the care & maintenance instructions below:

RECOMMENDED PRODUCTS:

We highly recommend Lakeside's Pristine Clean™ cleaner which has been specially and effectively formulated to be tough on germs and grime, and safe for our surfaces.

Otherwise, **slightly** abrasive sponges and cleaners are safe for porcelain surfaces. The following are safe and effective for spots and stains.

- Dawn soap
- Windex
- Lysol
- Soft Scrub
- Bar Keeper's Friend

DAILY CLEANING:

Wipe down your porcelain surfaces with a damp cloth or sponge. Dry completely with cloth or paper towel to avoid water spots. Use Pristine Clean or a mild dish soap as needed.

SPOTS AND STAINS:

Although Porcelain is very stain resistant, all spills should still be removed as quickly as possible, especially those with staining agents, acids, alkalis, and colorants.

Grease stains: Wipe the spot with Simple Green. Repeat as necessary. Follow cleaning with mild dish soap and water.

Food / Organic stains: Dilute dish soap with warm water and gently clean the stained area. Rinse the area with water, and repeat as necessary.

Stubborn spots: Use a slightly abrasive sponge and one of the recommended stain removers (above).

WHAT TO AVOID:

Avoid activities that may scratch or damage your porcelain surface such as:

- Cutting directly on the surface, especially with ceramic knives
- Steel wool
